LIZA LORENZETTI IS A SOCIAL WORKER, AN ACTIVIST AND ANTI-RACIST FEMINIST.

SHE HAS WORKED IN THE WOMEN'S SHELTER MOVEMENT FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS, IN PARTICULAR WITH IMMIGRANT AND REFUGEE WOMEN IMPACTED BY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND OTHER FORMS OF OPPRESSION.

HER CURRENT WORK IN COMMUNITY ORGANIZING, TEACHING AND RESEARCH IS GROUNDED IN THE PRAXIS OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND SOCIAL JUSTICE.

LIZA IS AN INSTRUCTOR IN THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL WORK AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALGARY.

HER PHD DISSERTATION WORK IS A CROSS-CULTURAL PARTICIPATORY ACTION RESEARCH STUDY WITH MEN TO DEFINE AND SUPPORT THEIR ROLES IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PREVENTION.



LANA WELLS HAS WORKED FOR NUMEROUS NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND WITH ALL THREE LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT AS A RESEARCHER, PLANNER, POLICY ANALYST, CHANGE MANAGER, PROJECT MANAGER, STRATEGIC AND BUSINESS PLANNER, EVALUATOR, FACILITATOR AND TRAINER.

HER AREAS OF EXPERTISE INCLUDE FAMILY VIOLENCE, WOMEN'S ISSUES, CHILDREN AND YOUTH SERVICES, SOCIAL JUSTICE AND SOCIAL CHANGE, ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGE AND THE NOT FOR PROFIT SECTOR.

CURRENTLY, LANA IS LEADING SHIFT: THE PROJECT TO END DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. THE PURPOSE OF SHIFT IS TO ENHANCE THE CAPACITY OF POLICY MAKERS, SYSTEMS LEADERS, CLINICIANS, SERVICE PROVIDERS AND THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE, TO SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCE THE RATES OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN ALBERTA.
